Summer Literacy Camp Counsellor

We are seeking applicants to fill the positions of Literacy Camp Counsellors for our Literacy Camp program, offered in collaboration with the Cree School Board. These literacy and wellness camps aim to promote a love of reading and learning, as well as increased self-confidence of children between the ages of 5 and 12 years old living in the Cree communities of Northern Quebec.

REQUIREMENTS

All candidates are encouraged to apply even if they do not meet all the following requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old, mature, punctual, responsible, and able to work with little supervision
- Enjoy working with young children. Previous experience is a bonus.
- Experience or interest in the fields of education, teaching or community programming
- Ability to work well in a team
- Be familiar with local agencies, leaders, culture and activities in the community

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

Successful candidates will work together with other camp counsellors to run the summer reading camp in the community. Together, they will organize and run various learning activities such as reading, writing, storytelling, arts, crafts, songs, music, games, etc for the children. Camp counsellors will also try to include as much community participation in the camps by inviting parents, elders, and other community members. There will be some administrative work involved. Some travelling will also be required, including attending an all-expenses paid training at the end of June.
