CALL FOR PROPOSALS

The Cree School Board is inviting proposals from registered non-profit organizations to deliver activities and services to vulnerable students, either directly or through their families, within the school outside of the regular instructional hours or through a network of local community organizations, local businesses, and regional health, social or justice systems.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Quebec Minister of Education, Recreation and Sports (MERS) has provided school boards with financial assistance for disbursement to projects promoting student retention and educational success.

The project plan may involve either regional coordination (awareness and promotional activities) or direct service (delivery of specific activities).

The Student Success Project Fund covers two broad areas:

- A) **Student retention and educational success** actions are those that encourage better academic performance and more involvement on the part of young people in their schooling and that influence their academics as well as the impact of family, personal, and social factors on their lives.
- B) **Reading and literacy of children and their parents** through research-based and sustainable approaches that have proven to be effective in addressing the emergent literacy of vulnerable learners and the upgrading of literacy skills of parents with little formal schooling.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Registered non-profit organizations providing services in the area of student success and retention and/or childhood and family literacy are invited to apply for funding.

Proposals for new projects or to supplement current and on-going projects will be considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Deadline to apply is March 16, 2018.

Complete the attached application form, making sure to fill in all the required fields. Do not neglect to indicate if the proposal is for a project starting a) April 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2018 or b) May 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019.
